**EXECUTIVE ORDER**

In accordance with the provisions of the National Environment Protection Act, 2007 (Chapter III, Article 20), the National Environment Commission shall be an independent authority and the highest decision making body on all matters related to the environment and its management in the country. To enable the Commission exercise the jurisdiction and powers and discharge the functions and duties conferred or imposed by the Act, the Commission members have been reconstituted with immediate effect.
